Elected an honorary member of the Society of Petroleum Engineers, the highest international acknowledgement of a select group of its members.

Raj Ershaghi is Omar B. Milligan Professor and Director of the Petroleum Engineering Program at the University of Southern California Viterbi School of Engineering. He also serves as Executive Director of the USC/Chevron Center for Interactive Smart Oilfield Technologies. His research focuses on reservoir characterization, naturally fractured reservoirs, unconventional resources, smart oilfield technologies, well testing, and improved recovery processes. Ershaghi received the 1983 SPE Distinguished Achievement Award for Petroleum Engineering Faculty and the 2010 SPE John Franklin Carl Award. He became an SPE Distinguished member in 1996, and has received several SPE regional awards since.
